Sharing The Vision

- The initial conversation with Pepa (and Charles for PEC folks) is to help lay out the process and steps, and to answer questions. The purpose of this conversation is to help you, as the ministry leader, start the process with minimal surprises and lots of support!

Meeting with Innovation and Support

- The committee will look over your 1-page document and ask questions, offer support and wonder with you about next steps.
- Plan to be in touch with your liaison at least 1x a month, they are in your corner

Moving through the Approval Steps

- Pepa and The Innovation and Support Committee will give you a timeline of the upcoming meetings and whether or not you will need to attend.
- Pepa will connect you with Shawn Kang from 1001 NWC of the PCUSA
