“Supporting the Safety and Welfare of Migrants”

Thanks for joining our webinar on June 18. Here is a summary of how you and your church can help, and how to get in touch with our partners.

La Colectiva NTX connects individuals and families across North Texas to information, resources, and community support before an immigration appointment, during times of uncertainty, or after a loved one has been detained. Its key point of contact with migrants and their families is a tent next to the ICE Field Office in Dallas. Volunteers staff the tent Monday through Saturday. You can help La Colectiva NTX by:

- **Field Office Tent Training** - Attend a training course to learn more about their work or as a required precursor to serving as a volunteer at the Field Office Tent. Training courses are held monthly (dates TBD). Complete this [Interest Form](#) to show your interest, and you will be contacted with the next date.
- **Meals Train for the Field Office Tent** - Sign up to deliver breakfast or lunch to the Field Office Tent as part of their Meal Train on their [Give In Kind page](#). DoorDash gift cards are also gratefully accepted for those who want to help but cannot deliver a meal – any amount is helpful. (send DD gift cards to lacolectivantx.meals@poca.us).
- **Gift Cards for Families of Detainees** - Donate Gas & Groceries Gift Cards. Each month La Colectiva gives physical gift cards for essentials to families of a detained community member. Amounts of \$25, \$50, \$100 at Aldi's, Walmart, HEB, La Fiesta, WinCo, Kroger, & Visa or Shell, Valero, Exxon or Visa are greatly appreciated. Gift cards must be physical gift cards – email care@colectivantx.org or call Nancy at 214-770-5431 to arrange for delivery/pickup.
- **Direct Mutual Aid** – Donate to the Mutual Aid Fund that provides critical support for families of detained community members, including rental assistance and other essential supports. Detained family members are often the primary breadwinners of their families. [Use this link to donate](#).

CLEAR DFW is an interfaith coalition of 40+ Dallas-area clergy who advocate for social justice from a faith perspective. CLEAR sponsors a weekly prayer vigil at the Dallas ICE Field Office, praying for and accompanying migrants, and praying that ICE act with justice and stop their own moral injury.
